

At Tranby, the world beyond the classroom offers endless opportunities for discovery, growth, and inspiration. Our curriculum is designed to harness the full potential of our stunning grounds, where nature becomes an integral part of the learning journey.

Here at The Croft, we understand that the best classrooms often have no walls.

Our outdoor learning experiences are woven throughout the year, seamlessly incorporating activities across all areas of the curriculum.

From weekly Welly Walks that spark curiosity and exploration to immersive Forest School sessions that foster resilience, creativity, and teamwork, our children thrive in the fresh air and open spaces.

With unlimited access to our unique and bespoke outdoor area, every child is encouraged to connect with nature, develop their physical skills, and nurture a lifelong love for learning.



Curiosity and creativity are qualities we encourage, along with managing risks. Forest Schools allows our children to work collaboratively to complete a range of physical, scientific and creative challenges as well as develop their communication and language skills.

To complement the learning taking place in our outstanding outdoor area, our pupils also experience weekly visits to our very own woodland area, situated in our magnificent grounds, to focus on Forest School skills development sessions.

These skills are progressive and focus on the changing seasons, exploring different environments, working with tools and fire safety.

In addition, our Reception children visit Meaux Abbey Farm, a fabulous ancient woodland off-site to put their developing skills into practice. These visits provide a full day of immersive learning in a beautiful, natural setting. Here, children will:

- Develop teamwork and collaboration skills.
- Deepen friendships through shared experiences.
- Learn a range of practical and survival skills.

• Apply classroom-based learning in a real-world context. During these visits, children are taught by our Forest

a seamless integration of indoor and outdoor learning.

We love to encourage bravery and safe risk-taking! Whether through climbing trees, balancing on obstacle courses or using tools at Forest Schools. Risky play enables our children to be bold, and adventurous and seek new challenges.

Solveosaurus Rex can reflect and improve. They work really hard to solve problems and find new ways of doing things.


Thinkadocuses are able to concentrate on a task for long periods of time. They think carefully about what they have learnt and can explain their ideas to others.

EXTENDED DAY

We understand that working parents have commitments that might not fit around standard school hours. To support busy Tranby families, our Extended Day is here for you from 07:30 to 18:00, 17:30 on a Friday, each school day for pupils from Reception to Year 6.

The service is free until 16:45, after which there is a £5 charge without a tea time snack or a £7.50 charge with a tea time snack.

We consider our Extended Day to be the 7th lesson of the day. With learning at the heart of everything we do here at Tranby, the provision gives our children further opportunities to develop their skills and knowledge beyond the curriculum.

Our after-school activities encompass 3 areas of enriched learning:

ACTIVE

Pupils are offered a variety of teacher-led, After School Care themed and sometimes, external activities each evening.

CREATIVE

Sessions are developed incorporating 'The Tranby Way', ensuring high expectations through learning both indoors and outdoors to develop the 'whole child.'

ACADEMIC

Teachers use their subject passions and specialisms to teach pupils new skills and knowledge beyond the curriculum.

You may opt to utilise our Extended Day provision out of need, but equally, given the advanced learning opportunity it provides, you may wish to utilise the Extended Day to further their knowledge and skills. We offer a variety of clubs, each with the goal of sparking interest and excitement in every pupil.

Alongside our Extended Day, we offer after-school clubs provided by Fit4Fun, led by Tom Farrow and his team whose enthusiasm and commitment to regular participation in sport and focus on health and active living has enabled them to establish a brilliant reputation since 2008.

LANGUAGES

Each Reception class has a maximum of 16 pupils, taught by a qualified teacher and supported by an experienced early years practitioner.

Extended Day Provision

Free of charge until 16:45, offering families flexibility and children enriching opportunities to explore their interests.

Strong Foundations

Clear routines, high expectations, and positive role models help children feel safe, supported, and increasingly independent.

Broad Co-Curricular Programme

Music, Sport, creative and academic clubs, plus leadership opportunities through School Action, Eco-Club, and charity work.

Whole Child Development

Academic progress is matched by personal, social, and emotional growth,. Children become confident, curious, and compassionate.

At Tranby, it's not just staff who nurture our youngest children – older pupils play a big part too. Prep, Senior and Sixth Form pupils share their talents in music, sport and academics. These touch points and relationship with older pupils don't just inspire learning, they help each child feel more confident as they step into the next stages of school.

Collaborative learning occurs throughout the year, alongside regular familiarisation visits and carefully planned activities. This helps to ensure the transition from The Croft, into Pre-Prep (Reception), and eventually into the Prep School is seamless and exciting for your child.
