#### **LANGUAGES**

In Reception, your child will begin the early learnings of languages through song, preparing them for lessons with Senior School language teachers in Y1

#### **SPORT**

Children start their journey with sports such as rugby, hockey, and football in Reception. Vitally, they learn the importance of team mentality, fairness and good sportsmanship

#### **MUSIC**

Passion and flair for music is nurtured from Reception, with music specialists teaching children the basics before they advance into Y1

### Small Class Sizes

Each Reception class has a maximum of 16 pupils, taught by a qualified teacher and supported by an experienced early years practitioner.

#### High Quality Teaching

Expert staff and excellent teacherto-child ratios ensure every child receives individual attention, encouragement, and challenge.

#### **Extended Day Provision**

Free of charge until 16:45, offering families flexibility and children enriching opportunities to explore their interests.

#### **Strong Foundations**

Clear routines, high expectations, and positive role models help children feel safe, supported, and increasingly independent.

## Broad Co-Curricular Programme

Music, Sport, creative and academic clubs, plus leadership opportunities through School Action, Eco-Club, and charity work.

# Whole Child Development

Academic progress is matched by personal, social, and emotional growth,. Children become confident, curious, and compassionate.

At Tranby, it's not just staff who nurture our youngest children – older pupils play a big part too. Prep, Senior and Sixth Form pupils share their talents in music, sport and academics. These touch points and relationship with older pupils don't just inspire learning, they help each child feel more confident as they step into the next stages of school.

Collaborative learning occurs throughout the year, alongside regular familiarisation visits and carefully planned activities. This helps to ensure the transition from The Croft, into Pre-Prep (Reception), and eventually into the Prep School is seamless and exciting for your child.


