# EDT Year in Industry Placements 2024/25 for current Year 13 students

EDT's placement applications for 2024/25 are now live! EDT's, The Year in Industry (YINI) Placement scheme, helps place school-leaving students into paid 12-month long placements into all areas of engineering, science (particularly physics), technology/electronics, maths, business, marketing and finance across the UK.

# How does the application process work?

Students register their interest via the website <a href="here">here</a>

- There is no charge for students to register.
- Students will apply for the specific roles that they're interested in.
- Students will receive CV/Interview advice and an interview with the team to help them prepare.
