

ARMY MEDICAL SERVICES BURSARIES

The Army can offer financial assistance and support while you complete your qualificat Medicine (up to £75,000)
Dentistry (up to £75,000)

Veterinary (up to £60,000) Pharmacy (up to £51,000)

Nursing (adult and mental health) (up to £42,000) In all cases, you'll need to pass the Army Officer Selection Board

HOW TO APPLY FOR A MEDICAL BURSARY

You must pass the Army Officer Selection Board for professionally qualified officers and a specialist selection You should apply no later than your second year to qualify for the full amount.

You should be aged between 18 and 39. Apply by the end of January, while you're still at university



Army Officer Scholarship Scheme

The Army Officer Scholarship Scheme guarantees your child up to £10,000 in financial support, starting in academic Year 13. It also guarantees your child a place at the Royal Military Academy Sandhurst and a career as an Army Officer when your child finishes education. Your child will receive £3,000 while they are in Year 13, then a Standard Bursary of £6,000 while they're studying at university (£7,000 for a 4-year degree).

Army Scholars can apply to join any Corps for which they are eligible. Your child does not have to make a final decision about which Regiment or Corps they want to join until they're at Sandhurst, unless they're thinking about joining as a Professionally Qualified Officer, such as a Doctor, Dentist or Lawyer.
