Exciting Opportunity: British Young Pilots Lunchtime Club

Tranby is excited to announce the potential launch of a **School Flying Club** in partnership with **British Young Pilots (BYP)**, starting in **September 2025** and we’d love to gauge interest from students and families. This is a truly exceptional co-curricular opportunity designed to inspire, challenge, and develop students through the world of aviation. Delivered by experienced BYP flying instructors, the club will offer weekly lunchtime sessions where students learn both **practical flying skills** using desktop simulators and **theoretical knowledge** in areas such as physics, meteorology, navigation, and engineering. Each half term, students will also have the chance to **fly a real aircraft**, applying what they’ve learned in the skies.

Beyond the excitement and adventure, flying fosters **confidence, self-belief**, and a genuine passion for **STEM subjects**, helping students make meaningful connections between classroom learning and real-world application.

Students may join for just a single term, but those who continue can progress through the official **BYP syllabus**, sitting civilian flight exams and, if committed, could even leave school with a **Private Pilot’s Licence**.

The club is open to students currently in **Years 6 to 12**. We’ll do our best to arrange the schedule to ensure as many students as possible can take part. Club sessions are led by a BYP instructor and cost **£33 per week**, paid termly. Physical flying lessons are optional and booked directly with BYP. They recommend two 30-minute flights per term at **£90 each**.

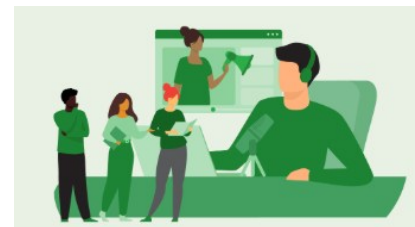

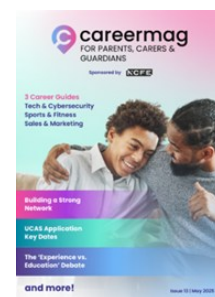

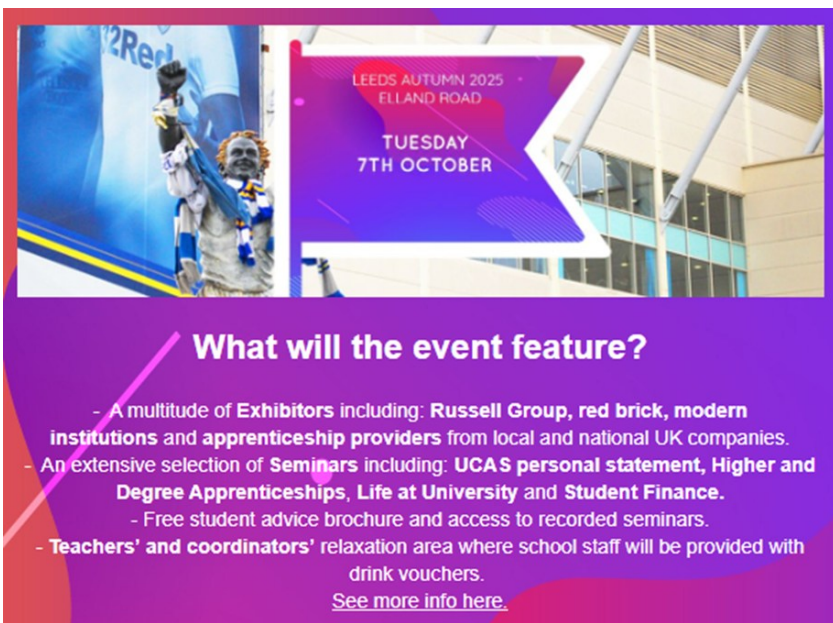
